As the year draws to a close, we thought we would summarise what has been achieved in Loiyangalani this year thanks to the generosity of you, our supporters and sponsors.

From our General Funds, raised from individual donations both one-off or regular, and from our fundraising events, we have provided for the Primary/Junior High School

- Breakfast daily for **1,100** children
- Sanitary towels/pants for older girls, and soap
- Salaries and transport for **2** teachers and **3** teaching assistants
- **3** solar batteries and related equipment
- **95** locking desks and chairs
- **150** Bibles for use in Religious Education classes
- Transport to and from school for sponsored students at secondary school
- Contribution to life transforming neck surgery for a secondary school student

Our Sponsors

have supported **25** children in Secondary School, **5** students training to be teachers and one on a vocational course in construction

Some have contributed to start up costs for students going on to Higher Education who have received Government grants and loans
